- 5. Submit an honors thesis to the thesis advisor one week prior to the final due date for thesis submittal. The final thesis must be submitted to the Administrative Assistant no later than 4:00 p.m. of the day falling eleven days prior to the last day of classes of the spring semester (Friday, 17 April 2020) and of the fall semester (Friday, 29 November 2019). No honors thesis will be accepted after this date. The Administrative Assistant will then distribute copies to a review committee. Honors theses will be read by the review committee and an oral presentation of the student's work will be given to the Department.

I further understand that if the conditions enumerated above are met, the review committee will review both the thesis/project and oral presentation and determine if they are of the exceptional quality which merits honors. The review committee will submit its recommendation to the Department for final adjudication.
